Financial Aid Opportunities for the 2016-2017 School Year

Meredith-Dunn School: To apply for financial aid, your child must have met all admissions guidelines and be accepted for school enrollment. Meredith-Dunn School offers financial aid to families based on financial need. A limited amount of funds are set aside each year by our Board of Trustees to be used for this purpose. Aid is awarded on a first come, first served basis by the Financial Aid Committee.
